

## General Practitioners Guide to Parkinson's Disease

This **6 hour online educational course** is brought to you by **Parkinson's Australia** and is accredited by the **Australian College of Rural and Remote Medicine (ACRRM)**. It is designed to help GPs address the issues of most concern when confronted with a patient who may have Parkinson's. It will prepare GPs to enact their role to assess, diagnose, treat and manage the care of patients with this illness. The course caters for learners with different levels of knowledge and experience in this area, while also providing flexibility in the way it can be used.

GPs have three options available for accessing information:

- Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs): important and practical information for immediate problems.
- Cases: realistic cases that allow GPs to collaborate with peers and apply clinical skills.
- Course: cohesive course integrating cases and answers to FAQs.
